- We will encourage and promote a team spirit and will endeavor to have our children attend all lessons, and events related to the Manning Park Nancy Greene Ski League.
- We will discuss any differences with ski coaches and officials away and distant from all children in a calm and dignified manner. We understand that the ski coach is in charge and has the position of authority over the children during lessons and events.
- We will always remember to set an exemplary example in all respects of the sport of skiing for the children, including abiding by all the rules of the Skiers

### Responsibility Code:

- Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
- Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield.
- Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
